Thesis: The Resurrection of Radical Pacifism: A Defense

Abstract: Radical pacifism (RP) is the view that violence against rights-bearers is necessarily

all-things-considered morally impermissible. Despite the near-consensus that RP is false, my dissertation offers an unqualified defense of RP across three papers. The first paper, "Animal Rights Pacifism," makes an abductive case that pacifism best explains our moral intuitions about harming humans in defense of (nonhuman) animals. The second paper, "Multiple Threats and the Specter of Pacifism," raises the stakes for anti-pacifists by demonstrating their intrinsic inability to establish upper limits on the number of liable parties one can defensively kill. The third paper, "Against Self-Defense," defends the view that persons have an inalienable moral right to be treated as extremely morally valuable, that this right is incompatible with the possibility of overdetermined permissible harming, and thus that pacifism is more likely true.
